If you are not sure where your designated space is, please see Kelsey or Danielle and they can direct you. Staff will be coming around during the drill and asking you to evacuate your apartment. This is a very important drill not only for residents, but staff, and they know the proper protocol. Please know that during evacuation for a tornado drill, you always have the right to refuse to participate, but know if a tornado does happen at our building, first responders will be coming to our “safe spaces” first.
